
The sun heats up the sea

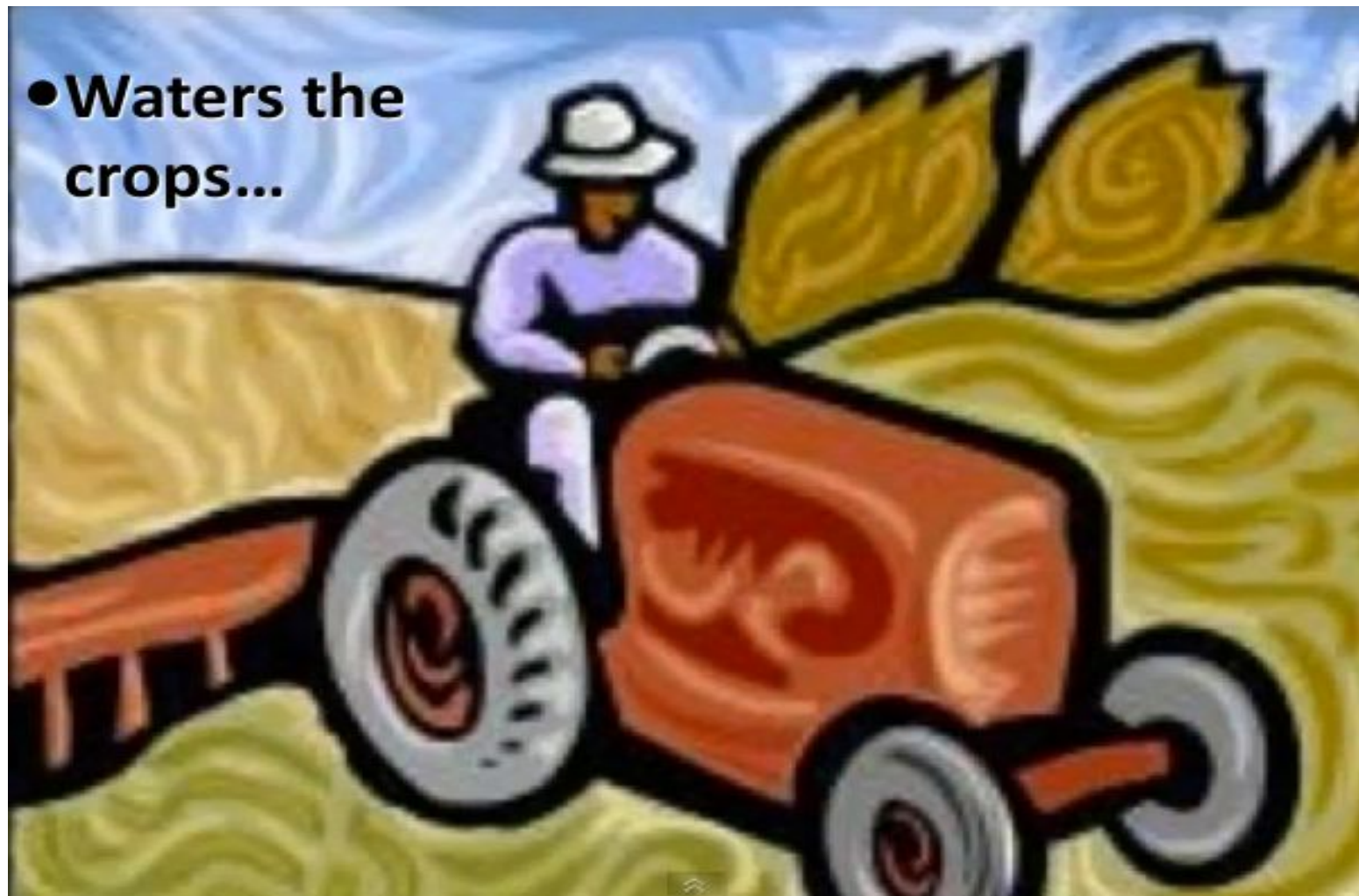

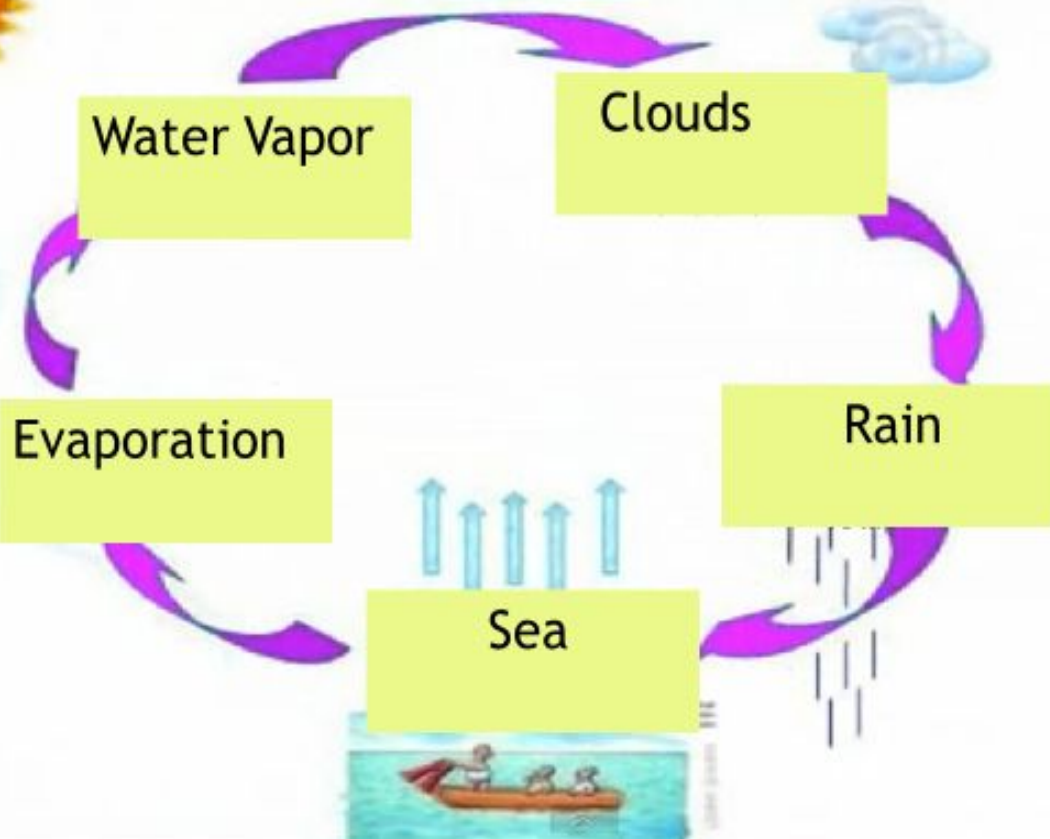


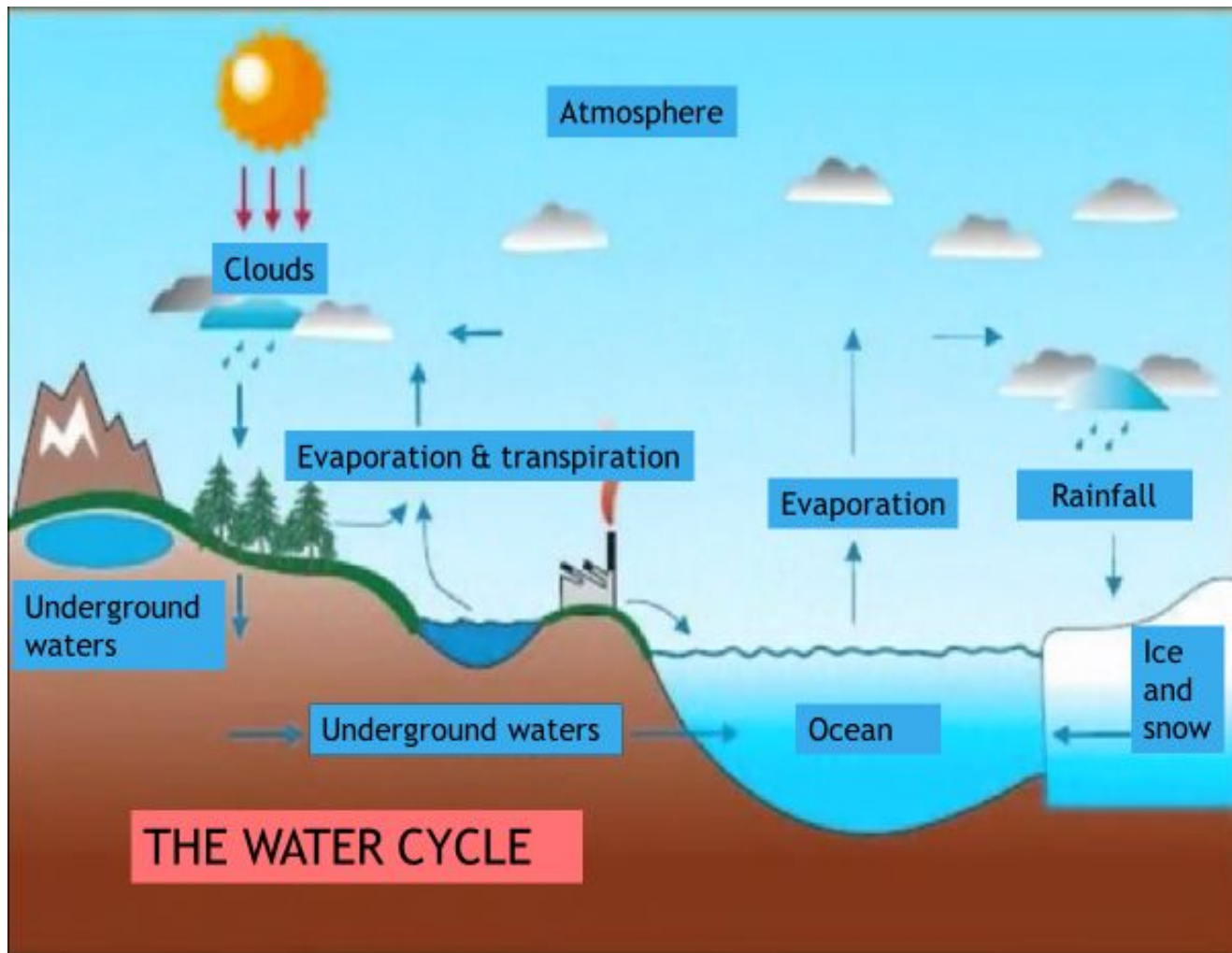
